

## Making Snowboard Mold Ribs - Part 4

The actual snowboard mold ribs are made by copying the mold rib template made in Part 3. This is done by:

- Cutting planks to a desired length
- Slightly offsetting the template shape and tracing it with a pencil
- Cutting along the drawn mold rib shape with a jig saw to make a 'rough snowboard mold rib'
- Using a trim router and the mold rib template to make an exact mold rib copy
- Repeating these steps until the desired number of mold ribs are made

### Tools/Tooling Used

- Measuring Tape
- Pencil
- Carpenter's Square
- Circular Saw
- Mold Rib Template
- Bar Clamps
- Jig Saw
- Woodcutting Jig Saw Blade
- Trim Router
- Bottom Mounted Bearing Flush Trim Bit
- Palm Sander
- Eye Protection
- Dust Mask
